Located in north west Queensland, Cannington is a fly-in fly-out mining and processing operation that has grown to become the world's largest and lowest cost producer of silver and lead.

Cannington consists of an underground mine accompanied by a metallurgical processing facility. Both open-stope and bench mining methods are used at Cannington, while grinding, sequential flotation and leaching

techniques are used to produce high-grade marketable lead and zinc concentrates that contain a high silver content.

Cannington is 100% owned by BHP Billiton. BHP Billiton is the world's largest diversified resources company with some 38,000 employees across 100 operations in approximately 25 countries around the world.

KEY FACTS

- In 2006 Cannington mined 3.1 million tonnes of ore and just over 3 million tonnes were processed.
- Cannington mine is a fly-in, fly-out operation due to its remote location, so we provide all employee flights to and from site within the Mount Isa/Townsville corridor.
- An accommodation village is where employees live while on site – it's a home away from home!
- The Cannington operation includes a rail-loading facility at Yurbi, about 15 kms east of Cloncurry, and a minerals concentrate handling facility at the Port of Townsville.
