Zones of Influence

The Primary Zone of Influence for Dendrobium Mine is defined as Mt Kembla (including William James Drive), Kembla Heights and the communities located along the Kemira Valley rail line (Figtree, Unanderra and Cordeaux Heights) within a 200 m corridor. These communities are deemed to be those which have the potential to be impacted by the Dendrobium Mine operational activities. The Secondary Zone of Influence is defined as those communities that may be impacted by traffic and rail movements associated with the Dendrobium Mine.
